

# **Docusign IDV Premier: Cheatsheet**

### General

Due to our change in the authentication provider, there are changes in the workflow for digitally signing documents. This document provides a brief overview of the new process.

### What is needed?

- o a valid ID document
- a mobile phone with a functional camera
- a stable internet connection
- o 10-15 minutes of time

## Process (around 15 minutes)

- 1. View the document via DocuSign the received DocuSign invitation.
- 2. Enter your phone number (for two-factor authentication)
- 3. Accept the terms and conditions.
- 4. <u>Requirement:</u> stable internet connection and working camera.
- 5. Select the ID document
- 6. Have the ID document checked according to the instructions.
- 7. Then take a short video selfie of yourself.
- 8. Perform the gestures as instructed.
- 9. The data is now checked asynchronously by certified agents (max. 15 minutes waiting time).
- 10. After verification, you will receive another email to sign the document.
- 11. Check the document and sign at the marked spots.
- 12. To complete the process, enter the code sent to your mobile phone.

#### Identity wallet

After the verification, an identity certificate (wallet) can be created to simplify the identity verification process for subsequent signatures.

- 1. The system recognizes that the identity has already been authenticated.
- 2. Use the biometric function of the mobile phone to allow use of the identity wallet (FaceID, fingerprint, ...)
- 3. For another qualified signature, only a QR code needs to be scanned with their mobile phone.
- 4. The data stored in the ID wallet is retrieved.
- 5. Finally, only the specified data needs to be confirmed.
